- 3. Keep six feet away from others at all times (EVEN while wearing a face covering!)




HAVE YOU HAD ANY OF THESE SYMPTOMS IN THE PAST 14 DAYS?

You must stay home until at least 72 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever reducing medications AND improvement in respiratory symptoms (such as cough and shortness of breath) if present AND at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

Cough	Sore throat
Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing	New loss of taste or smell
Fever or chills	Congestion or runny nose
Fatigue	Nausea or vomiting
Muscle or body aches	Diarrhea
Headache

HAVE YOU TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 OR HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?
